WHAT TOPICS WILL BE COVERED?

Core Course participant/tutor hours

- How do we support participants and tutors to adapt to attending remotely and remote delivery?
- Considering the impact of remote delivery on the group process and the typical challenges faced in adapting to remote delivery
 - Considering the practicalities of hybrid delivery models where participants may be attending either face to face or remotely
- Exploring how might we overcome these challenges and identifying the supports and resources available to help with this

Placements

- How do we support our participants to obtain and undertake remote placements safely without disadvantaging their development?
 - What are the typical challenges we may face regarding remote placements?
- What processes can training providers put in place/ what resources can be utilised to address the challenges faced and to ensure safe and ethical practice?
 - How can we work collaboratively with placement providers/ supervisors/ participants regarding the above?

Leading Skills training and Experiential Groups

- How do we adapt skills training and experiential groups to online delivery
- Identifying how remote delivery impacts on skills training and the experiential group process
- What are the typical challenges adapting skills training and experiential groups to online delivery and how might we overcome these?

- What are the typical challenges faced with remote assessment?
How might we overcome these and what resources can help?

Organisational

- How do we adapt our internal and external evaluation processes to online delivery?
