### 1. Submission requirements

As the author you should provide:

- articles of a maximum length of 2,000 words (including references);
- a high resolution digital photograph of yourself at the same time as submitting the article; the picture requires to be submitted in j peg format only
- your credit for example, name and job title; and
- a short biography of yourself (one or two sentences)
- the article by email

#### 2. Format

Submitted articles should have the following format:

- Rich Text format (.rtf) or normal Word document (.doc). For .docx documents, please contact marilyn@cosca.org.uk
- single line spacing
- text ranged from the left and paragraphs double spaced
- Times Roman, 12 point, if possible
- single spaces after all punctuation marks
- double quote marks for speech
- titles of publications in italics
- numbered pages with the title of the article repeated on each page (e.g., My article by John Smith/5).
- illustrations for any articles enclosed separately, as high resolution .jpeg files i.e. images should not be included in your text document.

#### 3. Editing of Submitted Articles

Please note that:

- the editor reserves the right to edit articles, but any substantial changes will be agreed with the author before going to print
- we may return the article to you for amendments (for example, if your piece is too long or if elements need to be edited or clarified)
