SANCTION NOTICES

Sanctions imposed are shown on the Register within the Profile of each Registrant.

There are three types of sanctions that COSCA publishes here:

Removal from the COSCA Register

Suspension from the COSCA Register

Sanctions Imposed

When sanctions are applied, COSCA will list the breaches of the COSCA Statement of Ethics and Code of Practice, and any other reason for the sanctions being imposed.

There are currently no sanctions applied to Registrants on the COSCA Register of Counsellors and Psychotherapists.

The Chair of the Ethics Committee will decide if the requirements of the sanction(s) have been fulfilled and whether the sanction(s) should be lifted. Depending on any cited mitigating circumstances, the Ethics Committee has the right to give an extension to the member to fulfill the requirements of the sanction(s). Failure or refusal to comply with a sanction may result in membership being withdrawn immediately. The Chief Executive will notify in writing the member complained against of any decision made in respect of the fulfilment or otherwise of the requirements of the sanction(s).
