HDS delivers a range of therapy services which includes a direct service to service users and through HDS' Employee Assisted Programme contracts. We are looking for an experienced Clinical Coordinator (Adult / Children and Young People) to focus on developing the HDS therapy services.

JOB SUMMARY

The Coordinator will also be responsible for ensuring the service is in line with governance guidelines, reporting directly to the Board of Trustees. They will act as first point of contact with service users and employers and allocate qualified counsellors. The Coordinator will provide support and guidance to counsellors and have responsibility for supporting up to 6 HDS students with their placements.

This is a part-time role (11.25 hours per week) and the post is funded for at least an 18 month period to allow the Coordinator to develop the service and investigate ongoing funding opportunities. The role can be undertaken from home however there is an expectation to attend the office from time to time.
